



From Sydney

Take the expressway to Penrith and then follow the Great Western Highway to Katoomba and Blackheath and on to Victoria Pass. After travelling down the steep descent through Victoria Pass you will come to Hartley (as distinct from Little Hartley). There is a sign saying 'Hartley Historic Village' on your left. Do not take this turn-off, but continue for another 1 km, then turn left off the Great Western Highway, at River Lett Hill (there is a large signpost indicating the direction to Oberon).

Continue along this road, passing through Hampton, and turn right approximately 4km beyond Hampton onto Duckmaloi Road. (Approximately 23.5km beyond the turn-off from the Great Western Highway.) The turn-off is obvious and is signposted "To Oberon". At this point it is 24km to the town of Oberon; 10km to Bindo Creek Cabins.

The entrance to Bindo Creek Cabins is about 10km after the turn-off, on the right hand side of Duckmaloi Road. The entry shared with Watersedge Cottage and is marked by a large Bindo Creek Cabins sign. (If you come to a concrete bridge over the Duckmaloi River, you have gone 1km too far)

Go over the cattle grid and up the gravel road taking you to the top of the hill approximately 1.5km to the Bindo Creek Cabins entrance cattle grid. From here you can see the cabins.

Travel time from Katoomba is approximately one hour and ten minutes.

From Bathurst

Turn right to Oberon at Kelso. Bindo Creek Cabins is 15km beyond the town of Oberon heading towards Sydney. The entrance is on the left side of Duckmaloi Road and is well marked by a large sign. (see above)
